The New Press is proud to honor **Frederick A.O. Schwarz Jr.** with a **2022 New Press Social Justice Award**. One of the nation's great legal voices, Schwarz's legal career at Cravath, Swaine & Moore was punctuated by high-level turns in public service over many decades: as Chief Counsel to the Senate Church Committee; as Corporation Counsel of New York City; as Chair of the New York City Charter Revision Commission; as Chair of the Fund for the City of New York; as Chair of The Atlantic Philanthropies; as Chief Counsel to the Brennan Center for Justice for two decades; and as Chair of the Board of the Natural Resources Defense Council. Few have made more fundamental contributions in the service of democracy and government accountability, and The New Press salutes Fritz Schwarz's peerless record.
